3:15 p.m. **The Postnuptial Agreement in Ohio. What is it? Where did it come from? What does it mean?**

Attorney Douglas Henry

1. The history of the antenuptial agreement in Ohio. Struggle to provide freedom to contract to married persons but preserve the institution of marriage in statute and common law.
2. Historically, Ohio was the only state that precluded any post-marital agreement between spouses not incident to immediate separation.
3. Ohio Senate bill 210 (“Regards legal agreements between spouses”) was signed by Governor DeWine on December 22, 2022 and goes into effect March 23, 2023.
4. The change to the law allows married couples to amend their antenuptial agreement.
5. Review of the method and requirements necessary to modify or terminate an antenuptial or postnuptial agreement.
